


We look forward to seeing you at many of these events.

Butterfly Body Bright: because every child deserves to feel bright in their body



The Butterfly Foundation has recently launched a new positive body image program for primary school students. Research highlights the need to foster a positive foundation for body satisfaction and healthy behaviours from childhood, with studies reporting body dissatisfaction starts young, with approximately 50% of pre-adolescent girls and, increasingly, pre-adolescent boys experiencing it.
