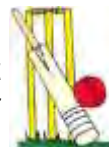

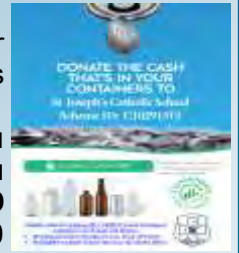
Containers for Change

Did you know Containers for Change recycling program is coming to WA on 1 Oct?

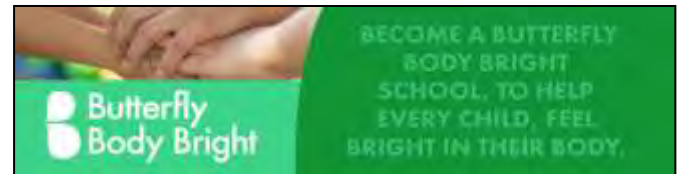
Did you also know that when you recycle your bottles or cans you can use our **Scheme ID (ID C10291312)** and we receive 10 cents for each bottle or container??

Butterfly Body Bright: because every child deserves to feel bright in their body



The Butterfly Foundation has recently launched a new positive body image program for primary school students. Research highlights the need to foster a positive foundation for body satisfaction and healthy behaviours from childhood, with studies reporting body dissatisfaction starts young, with approximately 50% of pre-adolescent girls and, increasingly, pre-adolescent boys experiencing it. This program aims to develop self-esteem and acceptance, as well as arm kids with the tools to call out bullying.

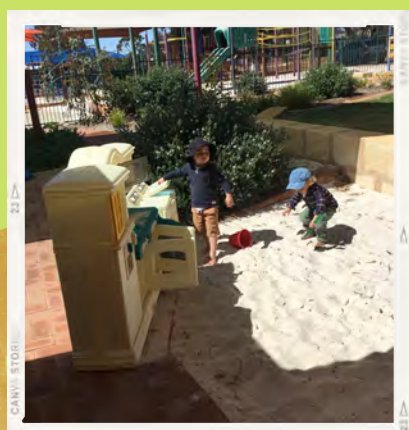
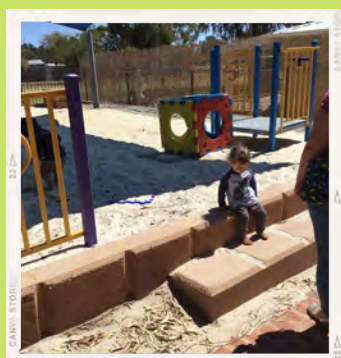
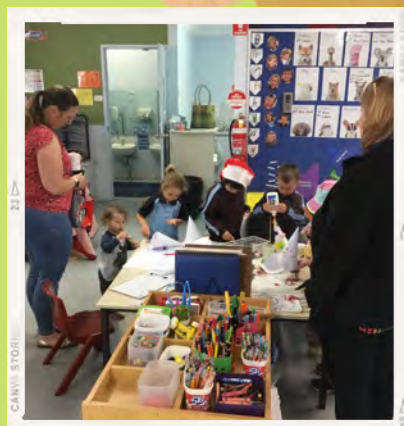
